

FELINE VACCINE PROTOCOL



What shots does my cat need? When does she need them? What do they do? Here are the answers to those questions!

1. Feline Core Vaccines (all felines receive)
 - a. Rabies
 - b. PanLeuk (MLV)
 - c. Herpes/Calcivirus
2. Feline Non-Core Vaccines (based on risk assessment)
 - a. FeLV
 - b. FIV (not given at SAH)
 - c. Chlamydia (not given at SAH)
3. Kitten Schedule
 - a. Series of boosters every 3-4 weeks between 6-14 weeks of age
 - b. Vaccinate only healthy kittens
4. Repeat core and non-core vaccines annually beginning at one year of age
5. Ensure FeLK is negative before starting FeLK vaccination. Testing is recommended at or after 8 weeks of age to minimize false negatives.
 - a. FeLK recommended at 8 and 12 weeks in the first year
 - b. Based on risk assessment after one year
 - i. Outside cats
 - ii. Multi-cat households
